We acknowledge the painful sharing of truths through representatives of NATSICC: the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Council within the 2023/24 Social Justice Statement (SJS) and thank them for their resilience and courage. We also recognise the support from the national bishops, as well as other people of faith and good will. We encourage those we encounter to hear the gracious call within the Uluru Statement from the Heart to walk with or accompany our Indigenous sisters and brothers toward true **Reconciliation**. May we heed the call to action to **Close the Gap** in disadvantage indicators to enable our First Nations Peoples to flourish – for fullness of life. May we also LISTEN with the ears of our hearts; so we can LEARN of the injustices that have impacted multiple generations through dispossession of land/ country, language, culture and the breakdown of kin relationships through the forcible removal of children, through stolen wages and stolen generations, including massacres; for 'the truth will set us free' (John 8: 32) on our shared journey of healing. May all of this be done in the spirit of faith, hope and LOVE - "for love can not only change individual lives, but it can change society for the better" (2023 SJS, p 19): 'Let all that you do be done in love' (1 Corinthians 16: 14).

Unlike the European calendar, there are six Noongar seasons in Western Australia's South West region, which are indicated by changes in local plants and animals. Learn how to pick the change of seasons with this handy guide.

Traditionally, Noongar people hunted and gathered food according to the seasons, being guided by the signs in nature as to which animal and plant resources were plentiful at those times.

Find explanations of the traditions and environmental indicators in the South West region of Western Australia for each of the Noongar seasons below.

**Bunuru** (February - March)

**Djeran** (April - May)

Makuru (June - July)

**Djilba** (August - September)

Kambarang (October - November)










## 1st March - WORLD DAY OF PRAYER ECUMENICAL SERVICE



Laudate Deum - Praise God

Pope Francis released the Apostolic Exhortation, Laudate Deum – Praise God on the Feast Day of St Francis of Assisi, the 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2023, which was also the end of the Season of Creation (From 1<sup>st</sup> September to 4<sup>th</sup> October annually). This was the urgent follow-up call to action for our global

community that came from the Encyclical (letter) by Pope Francis, Laudato Si' – On Care for Our Common Home (2015). This highlighted Catholic Social Teaching principles regarding stewardship, bringing Integral Ecology to the fore.
